## OesteCIM organizes an online session to disseminate the results of the Diagnostic Report for Gender Equality in the West

On April 27, 2022, OesteCIM will hold a session to present the results of the Western Region Intermunicipal Diagnosis Report for Gender Conciliation and Equality, in order to identify intervention priorities and opportunities for improving reconciliation policies between professional, family and personal life.

Starting at 10 am and ending at 12:30 pm, the initiative will feature the public presentation of the activities carried out so far: World Café, Focus Group and Digital Self-diagnosis Surveys.

From the activities carried out, fundamental information was collected for the elaboration of a basic proposal for an Action Plan composed of reconciliation and gender equality measures to be implemented in the Western Region.

With a duration of 24 months, the project aims to constitute itself as a pilot project in the development and implementation of effective policies and instruments in the areas of Gender Equality and Reconciliation of Professional, Family and Personal Life, in the 12 municipalities of the Western Region, in partnership with the Center for Gender and Equality (CGE).

The Oeste + Igual Project will promote the sharing of experience and good practices between the partner Center for Gender and Equality (Norway) and the inter-municipal structure of OesteCIM. This sharing will make it possible to design effective policies that meet identified needs, optimizing the use of resources and constantly measuring the impact of implemented measures.

Through the Agreement on the European Economic Area (EEA), Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway are partners in the internal market with the Member States of the European Union.

As a way of promoting a continuous and balanced strengthening of economic and trade relations, the parties to the EEA Agreement have established a multi-year Financial Mechanism, known as EEA Grants.
