New webinar within the scope of the Oeste Adapta Project analyzed the strategy and measures of adaptation of the Municipalities of the West to climate change.

The Oeste Adapta project, financed by the Environment, Climate Change and Low Carbon Economy Programme of the EEA Grants 2014-2021, promoted, on June 21st, 2022, between 9:55 am and 12:15 pm, Webinar #5 which aimed to define the local adaptation plan to climate change.

The Webinar was divided into the following moments:

- Parallel sessions with Municipal Technicians on the respective adaptation strategy and measures;
- Presentation of the Methodology for the adaptation action sheets;
- Presentation of the Methodology for evaluating the adaptive path;
- Scope and contents of the Climate Action Plan;
- Next steps.

The Project is in the last Phase, Phase 3, which lasts for 12 months, and corresponds to the adaptation strategy and action plan.

Once the Operational Strategy has been defined, adaptation will be integrated into Municipal Territorial Management Instruments and local mainstreaming of adaptation.
