OesteCIM will hold the first Webinar of the Oeste Adapta Project

On October 18th, at 9:50 am (Portugal), Webinar #1 - Climate Sensitivity Assessment of the Oeste Adapta Project will be held, financed through the Environment Program of the EEA Grants, operated in Portugal by the General Secretariat for the Environment, Ministry of Environment and Climate Action.

The objective of the initiative is to assess the status of the Project and analyze municipal climate risks. The Municipal Technicians from the departments of urban planning, environment and civil protection in the Western Region will thus be divided into 3 virtual rooms.

In these virtual rooms, Municipal Technicians together with the Project Partner, CEDRU, will analyze the current and future climate risks of the respective Municipalities. The Municipal Technicians will also have the opportunity to present and discuss the work they have developed to date.
