### OesteCIM promotes webinar to assess the adaptive capacity of West Municipalities to climate change

On December 14th, the second webinar will be held within the scope of the Oeste Adapta Project – Planning for Municipal Climate Adaptation in the Western Region, financed by the EEA Grants Programme.

The event features interventions by the Center for Studies and Regional and Urban Development (CEDRU) and Dr. Lídia Terra, Head of the Climate Action and Circular Economy Division at Loulé City Council.

The objective of this second Webinar is to take stock of the work, as well as the analysis of the surveys referring to the profile of climate impacts of the Municipalities and the methodologies and results of the analysis of the Municipal climate sensitivity.

The methodology for analyzing the adaptive capacity of the Municipalities of the West will also be presented and the methodology for analyzing the climate proofing of Local Plans, a tool designed to support the integration of the impacts of climate change, as well as the respective challenges and opportunities, in development planning, at the local level, making development measures more efficient and resilient.
