Oeste Adapta Project, EEA Grants - Workshop #1

The EEA Grants Oeste Adapta Project – Municipal Climate Adaptation Planning in the West Region, promoted, on May 31, between 10:00 am and 12:00 pm, the first technical training workshop to present the methodological program of the Municipal Adaptation Plans to Climate Change, the structure of the training program and identification of information needs.

The Workshop took place online, via the zoom platform and was attended by municipal technicians and OesteCIM technicians.

The initiative was divided into several moments:

1. Local adaptation to climate change: evolution, concepts and objectives
2. Municipal Plans for Adaptation to Climate Change: objectives, phasing and components
3. Training program
4. Methodology for preparing municipal adaptation plans - Institutional Articulation
5. Communication and awareness program
6. Next steps
