OesteCIM assesses future impacts and vulnerabilities of the Oeste territory

As part of the Oeste Adapta Project – Municipal Climate Adaptation Planning in the Western Region, financed by the European EEA Grants program, OesteCIM will hold the third Project Webinar on January 18, 2022, at 9:55 am.

The initiative is aimed at Municipal Technicians of the West and will be carried out online through Zoom videoconferencing.

Together with the team from the Center for Studies and Regional and Urban Development (CEDRU), the Municipal Technicians will take stock of the work and get to know the results of the climate sensitivity analysis of the respective Municipalities.

The Webinar will also present the results of the adaptive capacity assessment and the analysis of the Climate Proofing of Local Plans, as well as the Methodology for Analysis of Impacts and Future Vulnerabilities, thus fulfilling the work plan provided for in the Project.
